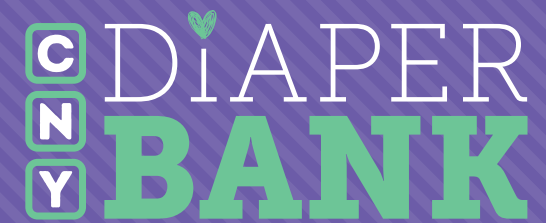

2022 diaper distribution



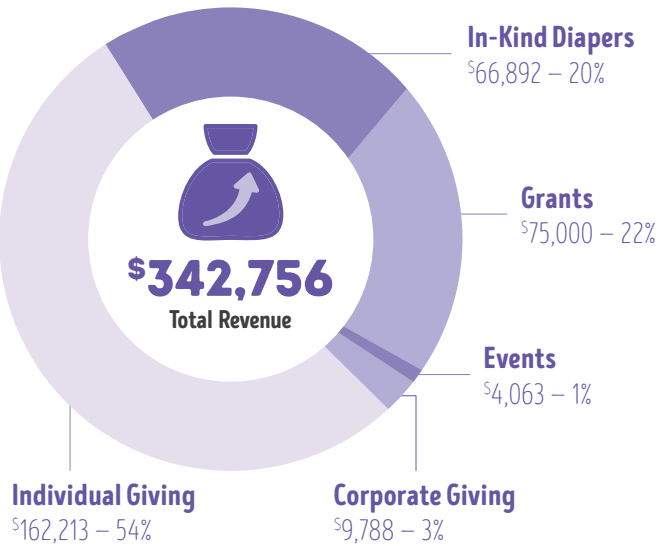
Since 2016, we have donated nearly 8 million diapers to families in need in Central New York. In 2022, we continued to build our partner network to reach more families.

As a volunteer-driven organization, we spend nearly every cent directly on purchasing diapers.

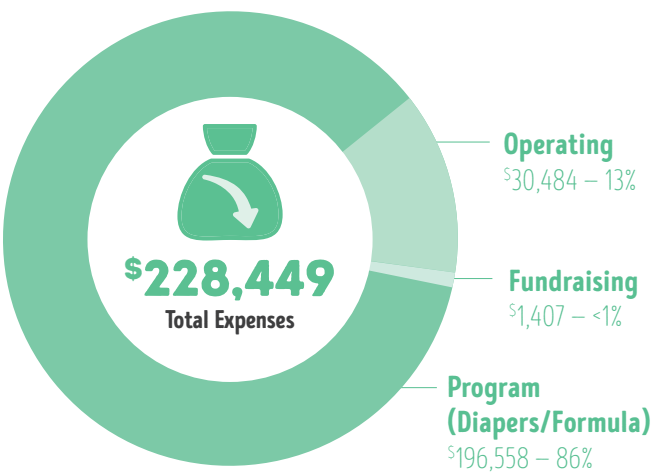

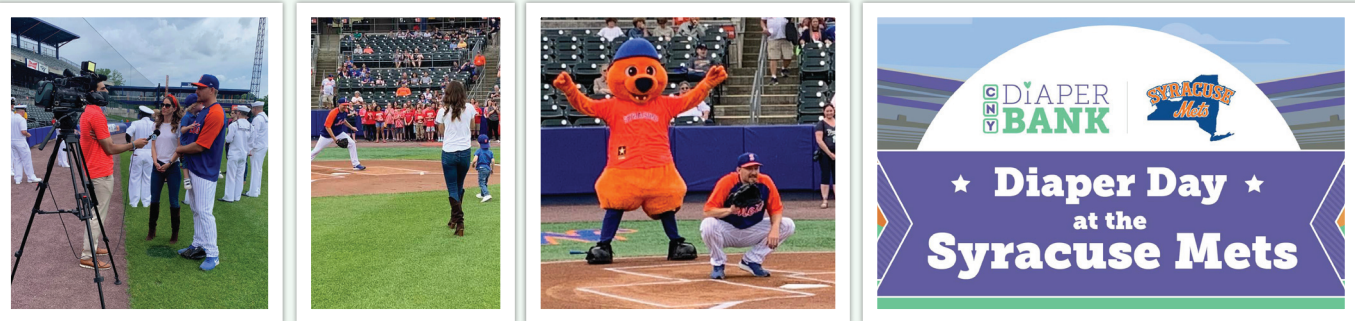

Partner agencies



In 2022, CNY Diaper Bank distributed diapers throughout a network of 48 partner agencies. When families receive diapers from a partner agency, they gain access to the additional programs and services offered. Often, diapers act as an incentive to bring families into a program. Our partners all agree that offering diapers strengthens their programs.

CNY Diaper Bank is proud to be a volunteer-driven organization.

Racking up more than 2,000 hours last year, our dedicated volunteers are responsible for most of our daily operations, including diaper packaging, inventory management and assembling partner orders. In addition, the community comes together throughout the year, showing the true spirit of volunteerism by organizing diaper drives and engaging local churches, teams and businesses. We are grateful for their energy and commitment to ending diaper need in Central New York.

"Ever since I began receiving diapers, the weight of financial uncertainty has lifted, erasing my worries about providing food for my children and meeting crucial expenses."

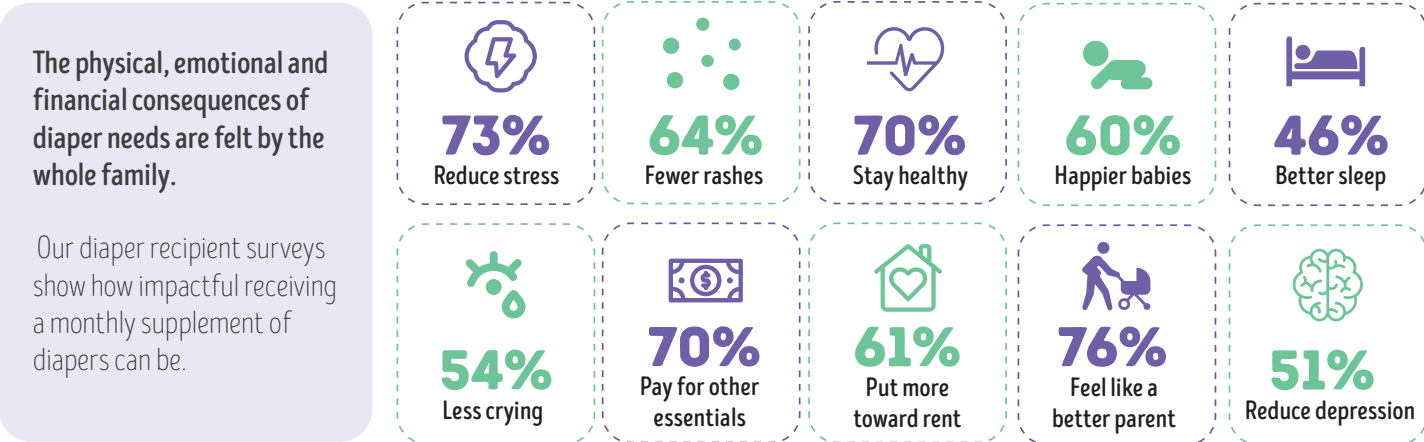
"I am a graduate student at SU, and, before receiving support through government programs, relied heavily on the Food Bank and Diaper Bank in supplying my family with what we needed to survive. What our partners are saying



All our partner agencies agree that distributing diapers each month:

- ♥ helps them to **build trust** with those they are serving
- ♥ significantly impacts their ability to **serve and sustain** the families they work with
- ♥ results in a **reduction in financial stress and anxiety** for families

"Each month our site moves out about 8,000 diapers to more than 200 families. Often, we are able to provide families with wipes, formula and hand sanitizer we get from the Diaper Bank, and the women of our church provide a bundle of sanitary pads for moms. We host our diaper distribution on the same day/time as our Emergency Food Distribution (which happens every Friday morning). On this same day, we also host many agencies from our network that are baby/child and family focused. Sites like Healthy Families, Planned Parenthood and ACR Health and nutrition professors from SU attend to infuse each family with information, resources, food for the week and hygiene items for mom and baby. The first Friday of each month has become our biggest day, when we see the most families, when we can do the most amount of work engaging with our community."

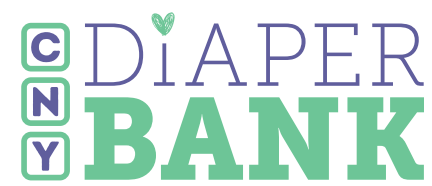
